## **ORDINANCE NO. 5407**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-108(a) OF THE CITY CODE OF LINDSBORG, KANSAS TO DIRECT MAYORAL APPOINTMENTS TO OCCUR ANNUALLY IN FEBRUARY.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Lindsborg, Kansas:

WHEREAS, Lindsborg City Code Section 2-108(a) currently directs the Mayor to appoint candidates to appointive positions at the first regular meeting in May of each year.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Lindsborg, Kansas desires to amend this date from May to February each year.

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 2-108(a) of the City Code of the City of Lindsborg Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

At the first regular meeting of the governing body in February of each year, the mayor shall appoint, with the city council's consent, a city administrator, city treasurer, fire chief, chief of police, municipal judge, director of public safety, city clerk, city attorney, public works director, parks and recreation director, and may appoint such other officers as may be deemed necessary. Officers so appointed and confirmed shall hold their office for a period of one year or until resignation, retirement, disqualification, or removal for cause by a two-thirds vote of the council, whichever occurs first.

- <u>Section 2</u>. All prior ordinances in conflict with the provisions herein are hereby repealed.
- <u>Section 3</u>. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
