RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LINDSBORG, KANSAS APPROVING THE SERVING OF COMPLIMENTARY ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR OR CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES AT EVENTS PROMOTING THE ARTS.

WHEREAS, Raymer Society for the Arts' mission is to preserve and promote the work and memory of Lester Raymer, and provide public opportunities for artistic and cultural enrichment.

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 41-104, complimentary alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage may be served at an event sponsored by a nonprofit organization promoting the arts so long as the event has been approved by the local governing body and the State of Kansas, Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control has been notified of such an event at least ten days in advance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to approve the Raymer Society for the Arts 2022 events for Makers Street on April 8, July 8, September 9, and November 11, 2022, and authorize the serving of complimentary alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LINDSBORG, KANSAS:

Section 1. The Governing Body hereby authorizes the serving of complimentary alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverages to members of the general public on unlicensed premises of businesses by the business owner or owner's agents at the above mentioned 2022 events promoting the arts, sponsored by Raymer Society for the Arts, a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization, provided that proper notification has been given to the State of Kansas, Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control no less than ten days in advance of the event in accordance with K.S.A. 41-104(i).

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately after its adoption by the governing body of the City.
